



Colonel Douglas W. Soderdahl, M.D. is fellowship trained urologist who most recently served as the Corps Specific Branch Proponent Officer for the Army Medical Corps

COL Soderdahl was commissioned through the ROTC program at Wheaton College, IL where he graduated *Summa Cum Laude* and was a Distinguished Military Graduate. He then received his medical degree from Northwestern University in 1991 and was inducted into the Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Medical Society. COL Soderdahl completed his Urology residency at Madigan Army Medical Center in 1997 and fellowship training in Laparoscopy and Endourology at the Eastern Virginia Medical School in 2004. COL Soderdahl is Board Certified by the American Board of Urology and previously served as the Urologic Surgery Consultant to the Army Surgery General. COL Soderdahl has held academic faculty appointments at the Medical College of Georgia and Eastern Virginia Medical School and is currently an Associate Professor of Surgery at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences. His professional affiliations include the American Urologic Association and the Society of Government Service Urologists.

Prior to his current assignment, COL Soderdahl has held many positions including Commanding a Medical Detachment in Korea as a General Medical Officer, as well as serving as Transitional Program Director and Chief of Urology at Eisenhower Army Medical Center in Augusta, GA. He served as the Chief of the Urology Service at BAMC from 2006-2014, Deputy Commander for Acute care from 2014-2015 and Deputy Commander for Surgical Services from 2015-2017. He is a dedicated surgeon, researcher, and educator and is actively involved in the San Antonio Uniformed Services Health Education Consortium Urology Residency program.

COL Soderdahl has performed award winning research and has collaborated in over 40 peer-reviewed publications, multiple textbook chapters as well as many research projects that have been presented at national and international scientific meetings. He also has received multiple military awards and recognition including the Legion of Merit, the Meritorious Service Medal and the Army Medical Department "A" Proficiency Designator for expertise and professional excellence in his specialty. He is a member of the Order of Military Merit. He has been deployed twice in support of OIF and OND, serving as a surgeon and Urology Theatre Consultant.
